





SCHOOL ZONE Parking offences



Penalties that apply in **School Zones** – current from 1 July 2017

	<p>No Stopping Means that under no circumstances are you permitted to stop on a length of road to which a No Stopping sign applies. Aus Road Rule - 167</p>	<p>Penalty \$330 + 2 demerit points</p>
	<p>No Parking Means that you have no more than 2 minutes for drop-offs or pick-ups and must stay within 3 metres of your vehicle. ARR - 168(1)</p>	<p>Penalty \$183 + 2 demerit points</p>
	<p>Bus Zone Means that you must not stop your vehicle in the indicated zone unless you are driving a public bus. ARR - 183(1)</p>	<p>Penalty \$330 + 2 demerit points</p>
	<p>Double Parking Means that you must not stop your vehicle or park in the middle of the road to drop people off or pick them up. ARR - 189</p>	<p>Penalty \$330 + 2 demerit points</p>




When it comes to child safety, Inner West Council makes no apologies for fining drivers who break the law around schools. If you are caught endangering a child by parking illegally in a school zone you will be fined.

Please note: fines are subject to change without notice. Penalties apply to offences in school zones during posted school hours on gazetted school days.

There are increased penalties and demerit points associated with parking and speeding offences in School Zones. The following offences carry the following fines and demerit points current from 1 July 2017:

<p>You must not stop or park your vehicle on or near a pedestrian crossing to drop people off or pick them up. ARR – 171(1)</p>	<p>Stop on/near pedestrian/marked foot crossing / children's crossing - \$439 + 2 demerit points</p>
<p>You must not stop or park your vehicle on or across a driveway, or block access to a property. ARR – 198(2)</p>	<p>Stop on or across a driveway or block access to a property in school zone – \$183 + 2 demerit points</p>
<p>You must not stop or park your vehicle on a footpath or nature strip in a built up area. This includes stopping with two wheels on the road and two on the path or nature strip. ARR-197(1)</p>	<p>Stop on path or nature strip in school zone - \$183 + 2 demerit points</p>
<p>Unless a sign allows you to park there, you must not stop or park your vehicle: ARR – 170(1-3)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Within 20 metres of an intersecting road at an intersection with traffic lights; • Within 10 metres of an intersecting road at an intersection without traffic lights including roundabouts. 	<p>If you stop in, on or near an intersection in school zone - fine from \$257</p> 
<p>Speeding Offences in School Zones attract higher fine and demerit points than other speeding offences</p>	<p>Speed in a school zone – fines start from \$189 + 2 demerit points (10km/h and under) to \$2,504 + 7 demerit points (over 45km/h) – Class A vehicle</p>
	<p>Make an illegal U turn in a School Zone – \$439 + 4 demerit points (ARR – 38)</p>
	<p>Drive using a hand-held mobile phone in a School Zone - \$439 + 4 demerit points (ARR 300-1)</p>
