Dear Parent or Carer

The *Validation of Assessment 4 Learning & Individual Development (VALID)* test for Year 10 students will be held on **Monday 4 September 2017**. The test takes approximately 70 minutes and will replace some of the normal Year 10 classes. The *VALID Science 10* test is an interactive, multimedia test completed entirely on a computer.

*VALID Science 10* contains multiple choice, short response and extended response tasks that are grouped around real-world issues, including scientific investigations. This is a diagnostic test, with tasks framed on Stage 5 outcomes and essential content in the *NSW Science Years K–10 Syllabus*. Students will be tested on their:

- knowledge and understanding of science
- understanding and skills in the process of scientific investigation
- ability to evaluate evidence, make judgements and think critically
- ability to access information and communicate scientific ideas.

Students also complete a survey about their opinions, attitudes and values about science.

Since students complete *VALID Science 10* on a computer, each student needs to bring **headphones or earbuds** that plug into a school computer. Earbuds for an iPod or portable player are suitable.

If your child has a disability that needs special consideration or has been educated in English for less than one year, please contact Mr Hasenbein (Science Faculty) to discuss special provisions for the test.

Results of the test will be available during Term 4 2017. Information about each student is treated confidentially and held securely to ensure that the right to privacy of all students is maintained. A personal report for each student will be sent to parents / carers to describe the science knowledge and skills demonstrated by the student in the test. There will also be information about how your child's results compare with overall performance of all students in the test. The results of the test will also contribute to the outcomes on your child's formal school report.
